→ ABOUT FENS FORUM

FENS Forum is the main European neuroscience meeting, covering disciplines from molecular techniques to clinical studies and from bench to bed side. A dense program of plenary lectures, special event lectures and symposia as well as a series of parallel oral sessions and poster sessions had become the popular standard of the FENS Forum. Since its establishment in 1998, the biannual event has become increasingly attractive for neuroscientists all over the world. Its attendance has steadily grown with an expected size of more than 6000 attendees and 150 exhibitors in 2010.

The **Federation of Neuroscience Societies (FENS)** has chosen Amsterdam, the Netherlands to host the 7th FENS Forum in 2010. Amsterdam has excellent meeting facilities and its central location ensures easy transport, making it attractive for researchers and clinicians to participate. Upfront to attract participants will be an appealing scientific program of the Forum in 2010, but a visit to Amsterdam will also be a memorable experience in a remarkable 17th century city center and a lively international cultural and artistic atmosphere.
